Project: Temporary Classrooms for Denholm Primary School

### Client need:

When Denholm Primary School was destroyed by fire in April 2006, it seemed inevitable that the children would suffer considerable disruption to their education. Scottish Borders Council identified a possible location for temporary classroom accommodation at nearby St Margaret's RC primary. The site was just large enough to allow the installation of three double classroom buildings. Although cost was an important consideration, the council really needed quick delivery with minimum disruption to the operation of the school.

### Our solution:

RB Farquhar were contacted by Scottish Borders Council in April and delivered the classroom units to site within two weeks and ready for occupation within a month. Using the company's nationwide stock of units we

were able to source, ship, lift and install on site within a very tight timescale by working closely with local contractors supplying groundworks and services. All the work was completed to high standards of health and safety.

### Result:

The children of Denholm Primary School and St Margaret's Primary School were able to continue their education with minimum disruption.
