Client: Buttons and Bows, Glasgow

Project: Nursery Accommodation, Glasgow

Client need:

Buttons and Bows, a privately run nursery in Glasgow needed to expand its childcare provision to meet demand in the area. Nursery accommodation is subject to rigorous local authority regulation and the new accommodation had to meet those requirements within a tight budget. The site for the temporary nursery accommodation was in the back garden of a residential property. Space was limited and there were large trees in the garden so access to the site was difficult.

Our solution:

We were able to offer Buttons and Bows a range of products that suited their requirements. Buttons and Bows were flexible about the internal layout and this allowed them greater choice of units. They chose a timber frame building in four sections, fitted out to a very high standard. We liaised with contractors to lay the foundations for the buildings and with the crane company for installation of the temporary nursery building.

Result:

After an initial 12 months lease, Buttons and Bows have extended their hire of the temporary accommodation for a further year.
