Client: Moray Council

Project: Temporary Office Buildings to House Staff and Services

### Client need:

When they decided to improve efficiency by centralising services from the surrounding area in Elgin, Moray Council sought a high quality temporary office solution that met the needs of both their staff and the public who would visit the offices. Time was a key issue because they needed to decant staff from existing offices and provide a seamless service. The proposed sites for the sectional offices were limited in space and accessibility and the client demanded offices which met the requirements of the Disability Discrimination Act and also provided adequate personal and circulation space to suit Local Authority needs. The sectional building was needed for a minimum of 52 weeks.

### Our solution:

Working closely with the client, RB Farquhar produced a design for two offices which met the requirements of Moray Council. Liaising with crane suppliers, the modular units were lifted onto the site and a link corridor was created to the existing council building.

### Result:

The building is on site and in operation and the council have a flexible solution to their accommodation problem, with the opportunity to extend hire if needed.
